SEAMEO Regional Open Learning Centreduly organized under the Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO), with principal office at KompleksUniversitasTerbuka, Jl. Cabe Raya, PondokCabe 15418, Jakarta, Indonesia, hereinafter referred to as SEAMEO SEAMOLECand represented in this instrument by its Director, Dr. Abi Sujak M.Sc

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Chengdu Textile Collegeislt is a three-year full-time college directly under the leadership of Sichuan Provincial Education Department and the sole College on textile operation and education in western China.

WHEREAS, SEAMEO SEAMOLEC is a Regional Centre for training and human resource development, research and development, information technology and consulting in the field of open and distance learning;

WHEREAS, University of Muhammadiyah Semarang is a higher learning institute duly registered as an education institution, was established based on the Ministerial Decree of the Minister of Education and Culture No. 139/D/O/1999. The university is a full-time institution of normal education, offering various undergraduate courses.

Development of Joint courses and education programs

 To conduct Joint Research, International Seminar, Conference, Symposium and Workshop.

This Memorandum of Understanding takes effect upon signing by the authorized representatives of both institutions, and remains in force for a period of 3 (three) years, subject to amendment at any time by mutual consent. The said agreement shall be extended for an additional period of 3 (three) years at each expiration date, unless either party gives written notice to terminate the agreement at least six months prior to the expiration date.
