



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) AND ACADEMIC COLLABORATION

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITY OF MUHAMMADIYAH SEMARANG, INDONESIA AND DAFFODIL INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY, DHAKA, BANGLADESH

University of Muhammadiyah Semarang, Indonesia and Daffodil International University, Dhaka, Bangladesh, aim to establish and develop a close partnership to promote academic and cultural exchanges between the two Institutions through mutual assistance, specially, in the areas of teaching and research.

This Agreement of Co-operation, upon approval of the authority of Daffodil International University and the University of Muhammadiyah Semarang, Indonesia will serve as a general framework for institutional co-operation. Each University will designate a liaison officer to co-ordinate the application of this Agreement in the best interest of both Institutions. Co-operative relations shall be carried out through the activities such as:

- > Student Exchange: Both institutions will cooperate to establish student exchange programs for undergraduate, Graduate and Ph.D with the approval of the two institutions in a mutually agreed manner.
- ➤ Faculty Exchange: The exchange of academic staff and faculties for short duration in order to share expertise and knowledge of two institutions in a mutually agreed manner.
- Semester Exchange: Both institutions will exchange students of undergraduate and graduate for one or more semester with the approval of the two institutions in a mutually agreed manner. Later, the academic credits of the student completed in partner institution will be accepted in the home institution.
- Summer/Spring Program: Both universities will agree to participate in short term Summer/Spring program arranged by other partner institution. In this matter, partner institution will circulate the notices among students and motivate them to attend the summer programmer for capacity building and cross cultural education.
- ➤ Joint Research Project: Students, teacher and staffs of both institutions may work on joint research project following a specific area in mutually agreed manner.
- Resources Share: The acquiescence of access to the Library database, Journal and other online resources for both staff and students of each university.

- ➤ Credit Transfer: This memorandum of understanding will be also effective for mutual credit transfer system for students of both undergraduate and graduate level to transfer their completed credit to the partner institution for further studies.
- ➤ Intern Exchange: To encourage young entrepreneurs, newly graduate and young teaching assistants, both institutions will facilitate them for internship placement from partner institution.
- > Scholarship Opportunity: Both Institution may arrange scholarship opportunity for meritorious students of partner institution and cooperate accordingly.

The provisions and activities specified in this Agreement are subjected to the availability of funds and the approval of the Authorized Officers of both Institutions. A separate financial agreement to be finalized prior to implementation of the program arrangement.

The Agreement shall take effect from the date of signing and shall be valid for an initial period of 5 (five) years. Any amendment and/or modification of this Agreement require the written approval of the Vice Chancellor of Daffodil International University and the Vice Rector of University of Muhammadiyah Semarang, Indonesia and shall be appended hereto. Neither University shall take action relative to this Agreement without consultation with the partner in this Agreement.
