



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITAS MUHAMMADIYAH SEMARANG, INDONESIA
AND
CENTRAL TAIWAN UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, TAIWAN**

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on this 11th day of December, 2017 between Universitas Muhammadiyah Semarang and Central Taiwan University of Science and Technology hereinafter referred to as "UNIMUS" and "CTUST".

1. UNIMUS and CTUST hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through research and study in furtherance of the advancement of learning as stated below:
 - (a) To encourage visits by faculty from one university to the other for the purpose of engaging in research and teaching programs;
 - (b) To promote the reciprocal exchange of qualified students;
 - (c) To foster the exchange of academic publications and scholarly information;
 - (d) To promote other academic activities which enhance the above mentioned goals;
 - (e) To encourage the formal collection and share of benchmarking data
2. UNIMUS and CTUST acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one university to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of Indonesia and Taiwan and shall comply with the regulations and policies of UNIMUS and CTUST.
3. UNIMUS and CTUST agree that all expenses, including research material, international and domestic travel, per diem, honoraria and all other costs, shall be the responsibility of the participating scholars and determined on a case-by-case basis. However, each side will make its best efforts to make available university accommodation to visiting faculty and students.
4. This MOU shall be executed on the date of signature and remain in effect for five (5) years. It shall be extended automatically for additional periods of five (5) years at each expiration date unless either party gives six (6) months' advance notice in writing to terminate the MOU.
5. Both universities agree that this Memorandum of Understanding is incorporated into, and will provide the foundation and framework for, projects developed by academic and administrative units from the two universities and documented in other subsequent Agreements.
