MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Faculty of Medical Technology Mahidol University

And

Faculty of Nursing and Health Science University of Muhammadiyah Semarang

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is intended to establish collaborative and mutually beneficial programs which serve to enhance academic, scientific and cultural cooperation between Faculty of Medical Technology, Mahidol University, Thailand and Faculty of Nursing and Health Science, University of Muhammadiyah Semarang, Indonesia. The two faculties agree to encourage the following programs and activities on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

- 1. Faculty of Medical Technology, Mahidol University and Faculty of Nursing and Health Science, University of Muhammadiyah Semarang desire to further develop and expand academic cooperation in teaching and research, in pursuit of advancing and reciprocally dissemination knowledge and academic resources, agree as follows;
- (a) to encourage, and use their best endeavors to effect visits from one university to the other by members of the academic staff for the purpose of teaching and research programs;
 - (b) to develop collaborative research and teaching programs;
 - (c) to exchange administrative staff;
 - (d) to promote the reciprocal exchange of qualified students;
 - (e) to pursue the exchange of academic materials, publications and information;
 - (f) to actively seek sources of funding for collaborative research and activities;
 - (g) to encourage the formal collection and share of benchmarking data
- 2. The faculties acknowledge that all visits of staff and students shall be subject to compliance with the prevailing entry and visa regulations and requirements of Thailand and Indonesia, as well as the respective institutions admission requirements.
- 3. The faculties acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses of salary, travel, living and allied costs of exchange programs will be jointly deliberated and agreed upon.
- 4. The faculties agree to review this agreement after two (2) years from the date hereof, while both faculties reserve the right to terminate this agreement at any time via six (6) months prior written notice.
